

# New York Outreach and Enrollment Summits 2016: Strengthening Outreach and Meeting Post-Enrollment Challenges

Over 2.8 million people have now been enrolled in the state marketplace, NY State of Health. Most did not have health coverage when they enrolled. This year's regional summits will begin with a presentation on the status of enrollment from NY State of Health.

As in past years, participants will share enrollment experiences, but this year we will also focus on identifying post-enrollment challenges, such as those that people face in using their health insurance effectively.

The summits will also discuss outreach to "hard-to-reach" individuals who are still uninsured. As before, navigators, health advocacy groups, health insurance plans, community groups, healthcare facilities, certified application counselors, unions and small businesses will come together to examine best practices and share strategies, resources and partnerships to maximize efforts.

We must ensure that everyone makes the best use of their health insurance, while continuing to make sure all remaining New Yorkers are covered.
