	CURRENT GOP PROPOSAL
1. Can you promise that <b>everyone who has coverage today will still have coverage?</b>	<b>F</b> 30 million at risk
2. Will you make coverage more affordable for people - <b>lowering their premiums, deductibles and out-of-pocket costs</b> - while not taking away any of their current benefits?	<b>F</b> Premiums could double
3. Will everyone who currently gets a health insurance tax credit <b>continue to receive the same amount or more so that they not only "have access to coverage" but can afford it?</b>	<b>F</b> Tax credits not tied to income
4. Will you <b>keep the current protections for people with pre-existing conditions</b> that are in the current law?	<b>F</b> Leaves sick on their own
5. Will you <b>guarantee that a woman can't be charged more than a man</b> for her health insurance simply because she is a woman?	<b>F</b> No information provided
6. Will insurance companies in all states still be required to <b>cover check-ups for kids, mammograms and birth control without co-pays?</b> Will you make sure that <b>treatment for mental health and substance abuse disorders and prescription drugs</b> will still be covered at the same level?	<b>F</b> No information provided
7. Will you <b>prevent insurance companies from charging people over 55 years of age more</b> than they are today?	<b>F</b> Will be charged more
8. Will <b>everyone that is covered today through Medicaid continue to have coverage</b> without paying more?	<b>F</b> Millions could lose care
9. Will you <b>require large companies and other big employers to continue providing health coverage</b> for their employees?	<b>F</b> Lets employers off the hook
10. Will you <b>cut taxes for pharmaceutical companies and the wealthiest?</b>	<b>A+</b>
