

# HOW TO VOTE IN NEW YORK STATE

## 1. ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

IF YOU ARE REGISTERED SEE PAGE 2 OF THIS FLIER ON DIFFERENT WAYS YOU CAN VOTE.

## 2. IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED, HERE ARE THREE WAYS TO REGISTER.

THE DEADLINE IS OCTOBER 9.

IN PERSON	YOU CAN REGISTER IN PERSON AT YOUR <a href="#">COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS</a> OR AT ANY NEW YORK STATE <a href="#">AGENCY-BASED VOTER REGISTRATION CENTER</a> .	OCTOBER 9, 2020 (FRIDAY)
BY PHONE	REQUEST A VOTER REGISTRATION FORM TO BE SENT TO YOU BY CALLING THE STATE HOTLINE AT 1-800-FOR-VOTE. ONCE YOU GET THE FORM, MAKE SURE TO SEND IT IN BY FRIDAY, OCT. 9	APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 9, 2020
BY MAIL	(1) ENTER YOUR NAME DIRECTLY INTO THE STATE'S MAILING LIST HERE <a href="https://www.elections.ny.gov/voterregsit/voterregistration">HTTPS://WWW.ELECTIONS.NY.GOV/VOTERREGSITE/VOTERREGISTRATION</a> OR GET THE FORM ONLINE AT <a href="https://www.elections.ny.gov/votingregister.html#voteregform">HTTPS://WWW.ELECTIONS.NY.GOV/VOTINGREGISTER.HTML#VOTEREGFORM</a> SCROLL DOWN TO "NEW YORK STATE VOTER REGISTRATION FORM" (2) ONCE THE FORM IS COMPLETED, YOU MUST PRINT THE FORM AND SIGN IT. NO DIGITAL SIGNATURE ACCEPTED. (3) MAIL THE FORM TO YOUR <a href="#">COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS</a> . POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, OCT. 9	APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 9, 2020

## 3. TO MAKE CHANGES TO YOUR REGISTRATION IF YOU ARE ALREADY REGISTERED (SUCH AS AN ADDRESS CHANGE) OR TO CANCEL YOUR REGISTRATION, VISIT

# HOW TO CAST YOUR VOTE

THIS YEAR, ALL REGISTERED VOTERS CAN REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IF THEY ARE CONCERNED ABOUT COVID-19 AND DO NOT WANT TO VOTE IN PERSON. SIGNED ABSENTEE BALLOTS CAN BE RETURNED TO DROP BOXES WITHOUT A WAIT AT OVER 300 LOCATIONS STATEWIDE.

**YOU CAN STILL VOTE IN PERSON IF YOU REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT. AT THE POLL SITE YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT WILL BE SET ASIDE AND NOT COUNTED.**

(C) BRING IT TO AN EARLY VOTING POLL SITE BETWEEN OCT. 24 AND NOV. 1 (D) BRING IT TO A POLL SITE ON NOV. 3 BY 9PM	OCTOBER 27, 2020 TO REQUEST BALLOT  YOU MUST APPLY ONLINE, POSTMARK, EMAIL OR FAX A COMPLETED APPLICATION OR LETTER REQUEST FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION ABSENTEE BALLOT NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 27, 2020
