- The Senate is tightly contested with a 50/50 split in party seats.
- Past elections have shown that a small increase in voter turnout can change the outcome of races.

DEADLINES TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT:

IN PERSON: November 7, 2022 BY MAIL: Received by October 24, 2022 ONLINE: October 24, 2022

The absentee/mail-in ballot return deadline in-person is November 8, 2022 By mail, your absentee ballot must be postmarked by November 8, 2022

Voters are <u>NOT REQUIRED</u> to present ID at the polls. The polls on Election Day are open from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.
